Aluminium-PVC windows in the hospitality trade

The aim when rebuilding the sports centre and adjacent pizzeria in South Tyrol's Vinschgau Valley was to allow as much light as possible into the interior. FIN-72 series windows in the Nova-line version provided the perfect solution. The glass covering the frame on the exterior minimises the outer contours and thus maximises the light entering. The coloured housings for the blinds enliven the building architecture, thus enhancing its recognition value. The PVC core and centre sealing ensure very good thermal insulation values.
